Dr. Kenney is a Certified Breath Alcohol Tester by LifeLoc Technologies and uses a LifeLoc Technologies Phoenix Portable Breath Analyzer with TRC to perform his breath alcohol examinations. Our office is a certified AA Pre-employment clinic and uses a certified MRO. We can even help you develop an effective drug and alcohol policy for your business.



Forensic and Consulting Services

Dr. Kenney has been performing independent chiropractic medical examinations and forensic chiropractic reviews for insurers since 1992. His examinations are complete, accurate, defensible, and documented. Reports are referenced and allow the requesting agency to review the case under review with all the information in front of them. Dr. Kenney utilizes psychometric instruments as well as standardized testing to document the presence or absence of non-physiologic factors. His reports provide quantitative as well as qualitative measures when comparing performance against established normative data.

Impairment Rating - Impairment rating are accomplished using the criteria and protocols delineated in the American Medical Association's Guides to the Evaluation of Permanent Impairment. The most current edition of the "Guides" is always used.

Expert Witness/Case Review Services - Dr. Kenney is available for case reviews and to serve as an expert chiropractic witness.

Other Services We Provide

Functional Capacity Evaluations/Disability Evaluation - Functional Capacity Evaluations (FCE) enable a doctor, attorney, case manager, insurance adjuster, or disability hearings officer to more accurately assess the examinee's ability to perform the activities of daily living and their functional losses at the time of the evaluation. FCEs are evaluated using the NADEP model and criteria in selected characteristics of occupations defined in the Revised Dictionary of Occupational Titles, and the Enhanced Guide For Occupational Exploration.

On Site Diagnostics, including on site diagnostic x-ray facilities. In addition, we are equipped with computerized inclinometers, muscle and grip strength testers and nerve conduction velocity testing equipment.

Physiotherapy, including electric muscle stimulation, interferential muscle stimulation, ultrasound, traction, as well as rehabilitative exercises and activities for daily living.
